**Crossroads of Ohio!**

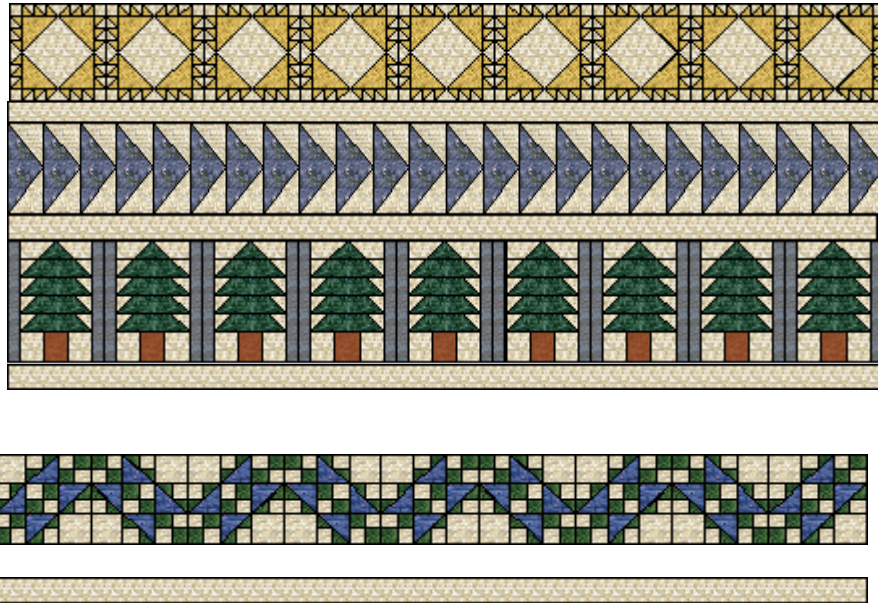
8" by 8" Block

Plus 4th sashing

Crossroads of Ohio block instructions below or you may download  
the PDF file

Please remember to read *all instructions* before making the block!

Instructions given are for a single block  
There are 9 "Crossroads of Ohio" blocks in this quilt



The *finished* sashings are 2 inches wide by 72 ½ inches long and is of the *background* fabric  
You will cut 2 strips that are 2 ½ inches wide by Width of Fabric and then sew them together to  
make one long strip and cut to 73 inches long, this will go between your fourth and fifth row.

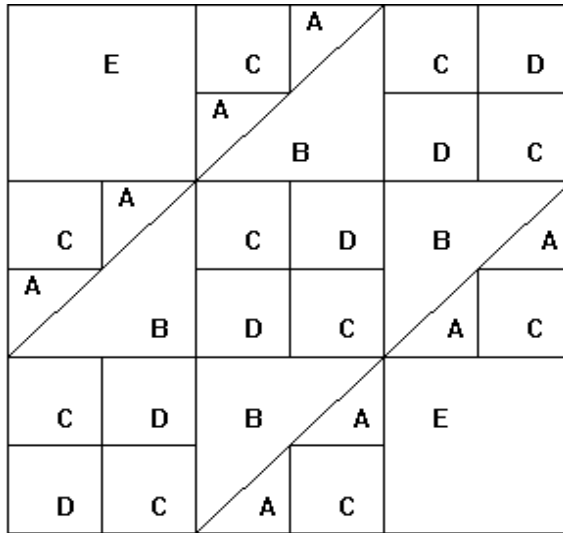
For the Crossroads of Ohio Block in the Quilt: You will need

1/8 yard of blue floral fabric

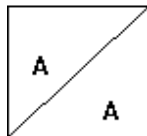
1/8 yard of dark green fabric

1/3 yard of beige background  
fabric

# Instructions for Crossroads of Ohio!

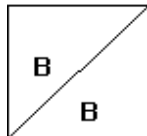


**Crossroads of Ohio**  
8' finished block



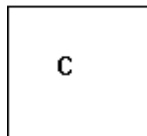
Cut a total of 4  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  inch squares from your dark green fabric

Sub cut into 8 triangles

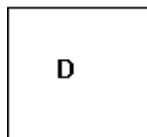


Cut a total of 2  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  inch squares from your blue fabric

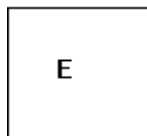
Sub cut into 4 triangles



Cut 10 pieces of the background fabric into  $1 \frac{7}{8}$  inch squares

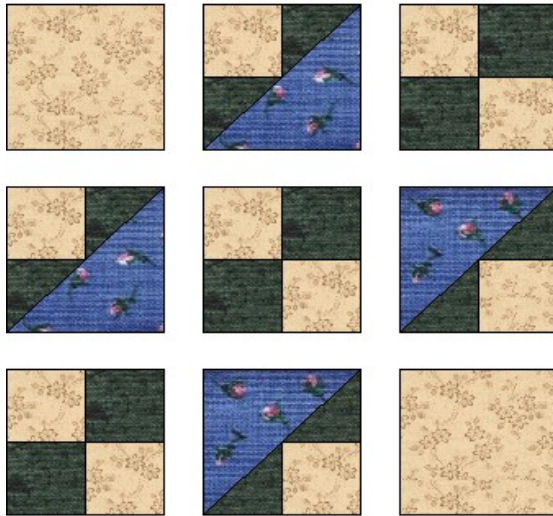


Cut 6 pieces of the dark green fabric into  $1 \frac{7}{8}$  inch squares



Cut 2 pieces of the background fabric into  $3 \frac{1}{8}$  inch squares





Sew them all together and there you have it!

**Don't forget to alternate the "roads" when placing them into the quilt!**
