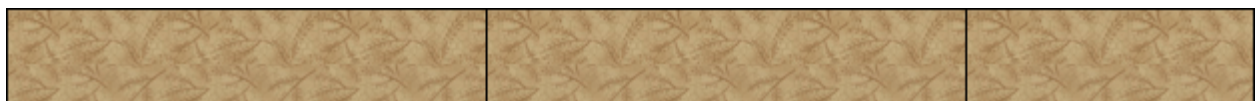
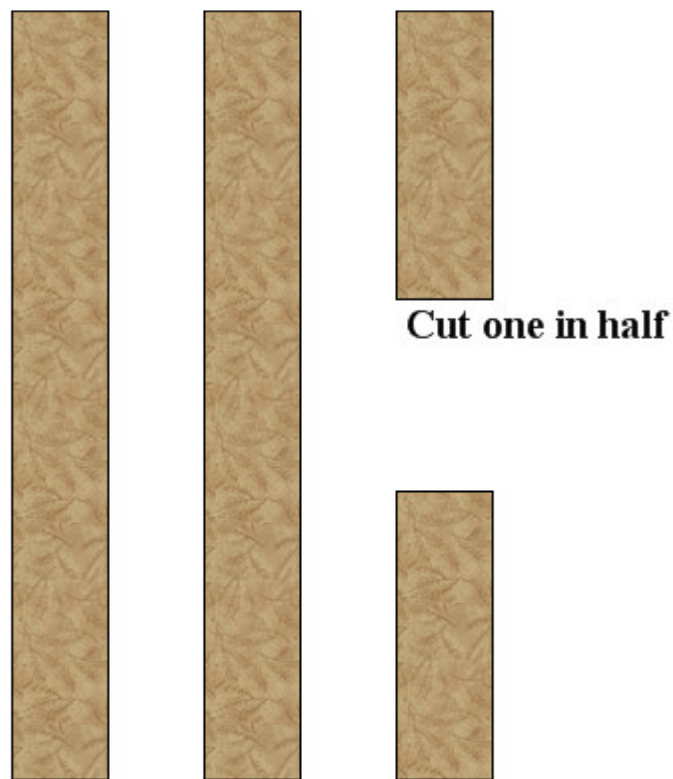


Finishing Instructions For My Home Town Quilt

From the background fabric cut 9 strips that are 3 1/2" by Width of Fabric. These will be your border pieces. You will be sewing the side borders first.



Sew 2 long pieces and one short piece together to make 1 long side border. Press. Repeat procedure with 2 more long pieces and one short. Press. You should now have 2 long side pieces. Sew them to the sides of your quilt top. Press and trim to fit.

Step 2



Take the remaining 4 border pieces and sew two of them together. Press. Repeat with the other two pieces and press. Sew one long piece to the top and one to the bottom. Press and trim to fit.

Sandwich your backing and batting and quilt as desired

For Binding

Cut 9 strips that are 4" by Width of Fabric. Sew these all together and press seams. Fold over with wrong sides together and press. With right sides together and raw edges even sew to quilt and then turn to backside and hand sew the binding down.
