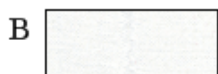


My Tulip Garden

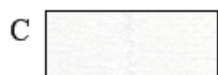
Finished block measures
12" wide by 12" high



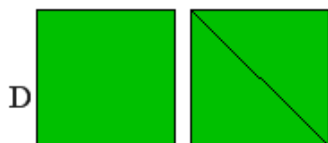
Cut 2 squares, $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " and then subcut these into 8 triangles. You will need to use 6 of the triangles for this block.



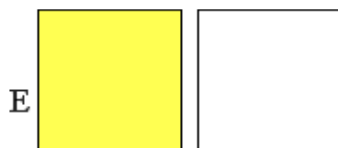
Cut 2 rectangles, $2 \frac{1}{4}$ in. High by $3 \frac{1}{2}$ in. Wide



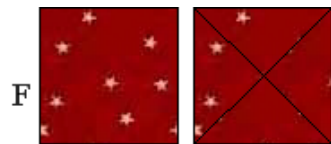
Cut 2 rectangles, $2 \frac{1}{4}$ in. High by $4 \frac{1}{4}$ in. Wide



Cut 6 squares that are $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " and then mark a diagonal line through the center of each square. This will be your sewing line.



Cut 3 squares, $1 \frac{7}{8}$ " Square



Cut 1 square, $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " and then subcut into 4 triangles, you will only be using 3 of the triangles for this block.



Cut 2 squares, $4 \frac{7}{8}$ " and then subcut into 4 triangles. You will only be using 3 of the triangles for this block.



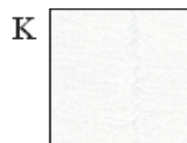
Cut 2 rectangles that are 1" by 7"



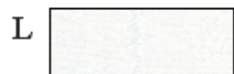
Cut one rectangle that is 1" by 3"



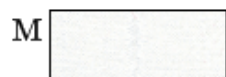
Cut one rectangle, 2" by $12 \frac{1}{2}$ "



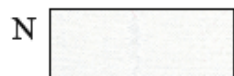
Cut one square, $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut 2 rectangles, $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " by 3"

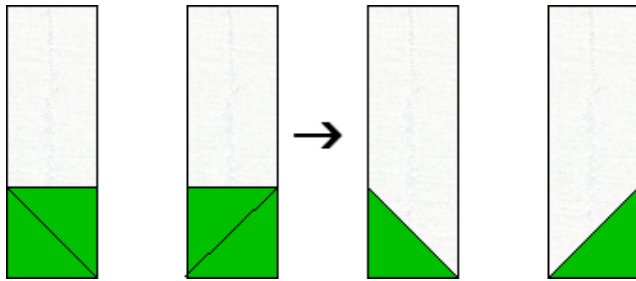
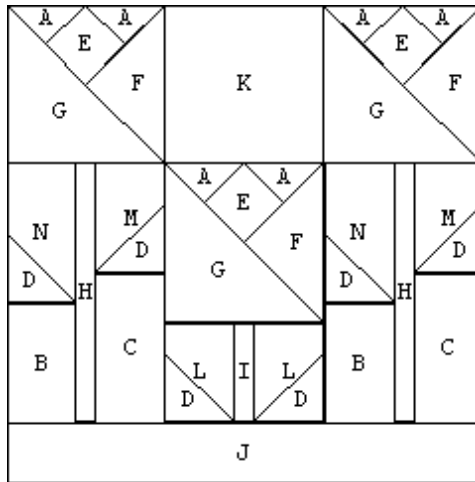


Cut 2 rectangles $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " by $3 \frac{1}{4}$ "



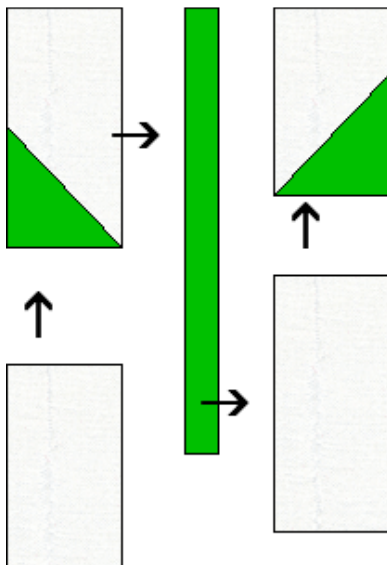
Cut 2 rectangles, $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " by 4"

Please use the chart provided below, to help you with placement of the various pieces!



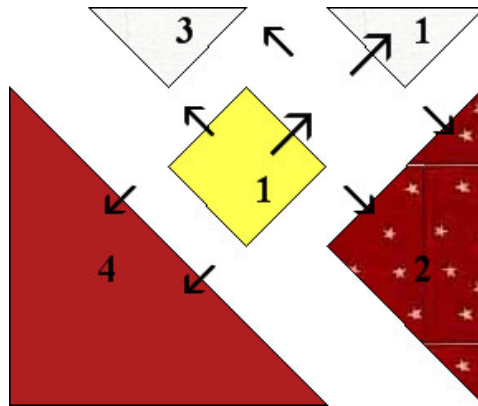
Take the white rectangles and place wrong sides together with the green squares with the diagonal line drawn on. Sew on the line, press and trim as shown in picture. Repeat procedure for all 3 "stem units". Press

Do this using pieces N, M, and L and the D green squares



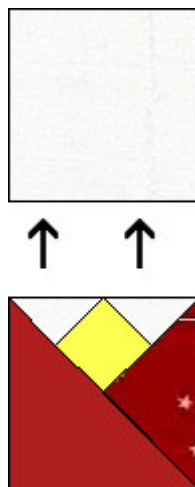
Using a 1/4" seam, sew your "stem units" together as shown in the picture

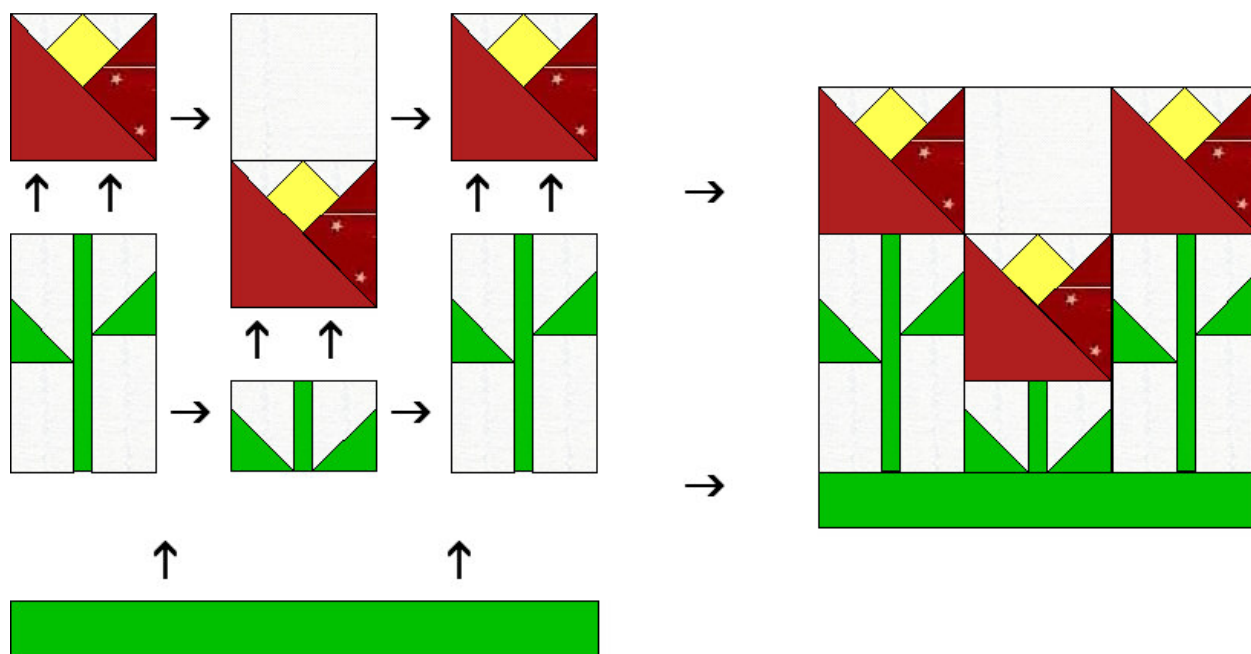
When making the 3 “heads” of the tulips, make sure to watch your seam allowances and when pressing remember not to stretch the bias!



1. Take a white triangle and sew to the side of the yellow square.
2. Then sew this unit to the dotted triangle.
3. Next, sew the other white triangle to that.
4. Sew that unit to the side of the red triangle.

You should now have 3 separate “stem units, two long ones for the sides, and one short center. For the shorter center unit, you will sew the white 4 1/2” square using a 1/4 “ seam to the top of the “stem unit” before proceeding on to assembling the block.





Using a 1/4" seam allowance sew your block together using the picture as your guide. Your block should now measure 12 1/2" Unfinished!
