

Pinwheel Frenzy!

Finished block measures 12" by 12" when finished



Cut 8 pieces that are 2 1/2 Inch Square



Cut 4 rectangles that are 2 1/2 in. High by 6 1/2 in. Wide



Cut 8 pieces that are 2 7/8 Inch Square, draw a line diagonally through the center. Set aside.



Cut 8 pieces that are 2 7/8 Inch Square

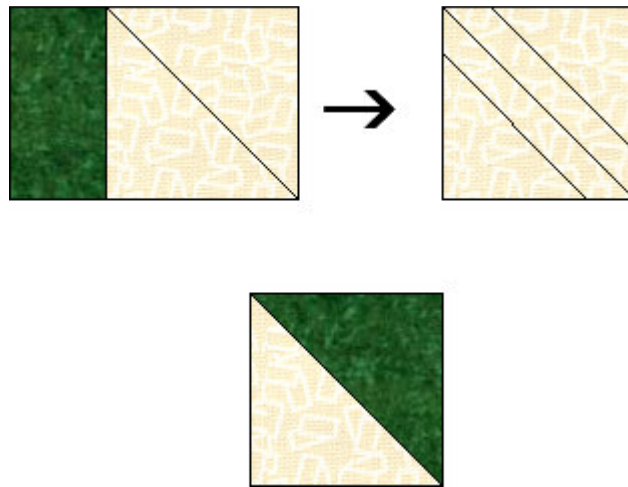
Tip for beginners:

Unfinished means: Before sewing your block into the quilt

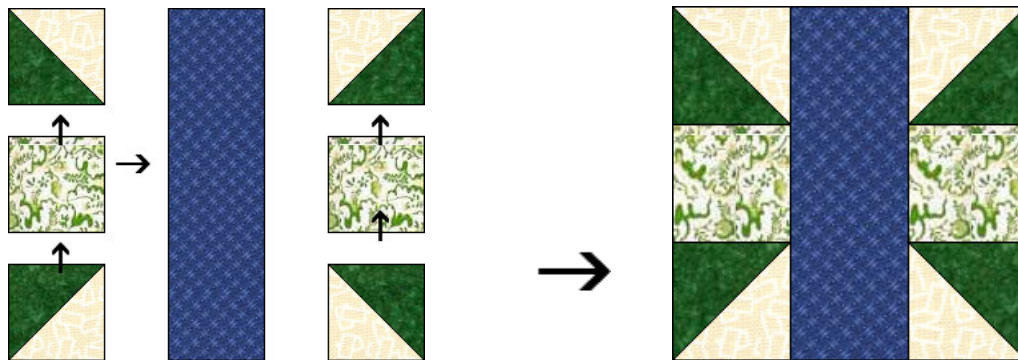
Finished means: After sewing your blocks together to make your quilt

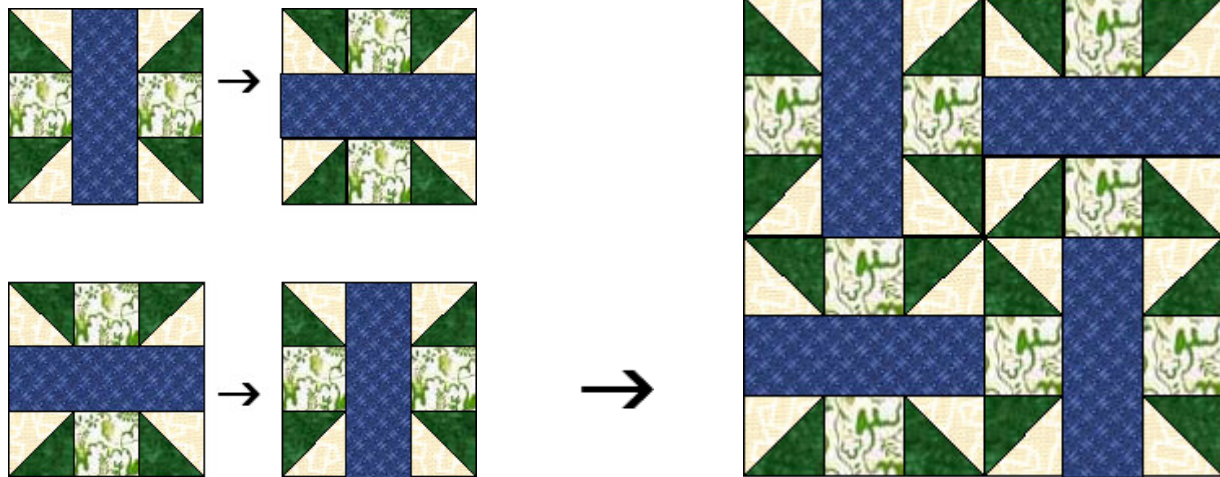
Lay the cream $2 \frac{7}{8}$ inch square on top of the green $2 \frac{7}{8}$ inch square and sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from your drawn line. Repeat on the other side of the line. Press, Then cut apart on the drawn line.

Open and press towards the dark side. Repeat for all 8 green and cream $2 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares. You should now have a total of 16 half square triangles.



Sew the half square triangles together to the light green print as shown. Then sew to the blue rectangle and press. Repeat this for the remaining units, to make a total of 4 units like this one.





Using the block picture as your guide, and using a scant 1/4 inch seam, sew the top 2 units together making sure to place each one in the correct position before sewing, then sew the bottom 2 units together, making sure to press in opposite directions so the center seam will lock together. Next sew the top and bottom units together and press.

Your block should now measure 12 1/2 inches unfinished!

Bonus this week!

This would make an stunning quilt for the beginner, use any colors you choose!

If interested in making a quilt from this block then look below for some information. I have had many emails from ladies who would like to know what it would take to make up some of these blocks into quilts and so I am providing the information. But.....keep in mind that I designed this quilt using my Quilt Pro program and that I have only made the one block and not the entire quilt. The information I am giving you is only an estimate! I am giving the details and not the instructions about putting it together. If you are still interested then scroll down for the information.

Pinwheel Frenzy

68" Wide by 80" High

20 total blocks in the quilt

Quilt has 4 borders

Border #1 is 2" wide

Border #2 is 2" wide

Border #3 is 2" wide

Border #4 is 4" wide

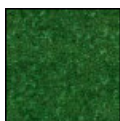
All borders are mitered

Binding of choice is 1" finished:

you will need 312" of binding that is 2 1/2 " wide

Fabric Requirements

Based on fabric that is at least 40" wide



Dark Green 2 1/4 yards



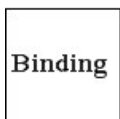
Cream 2 1/8 yards



Blue 2 Yards

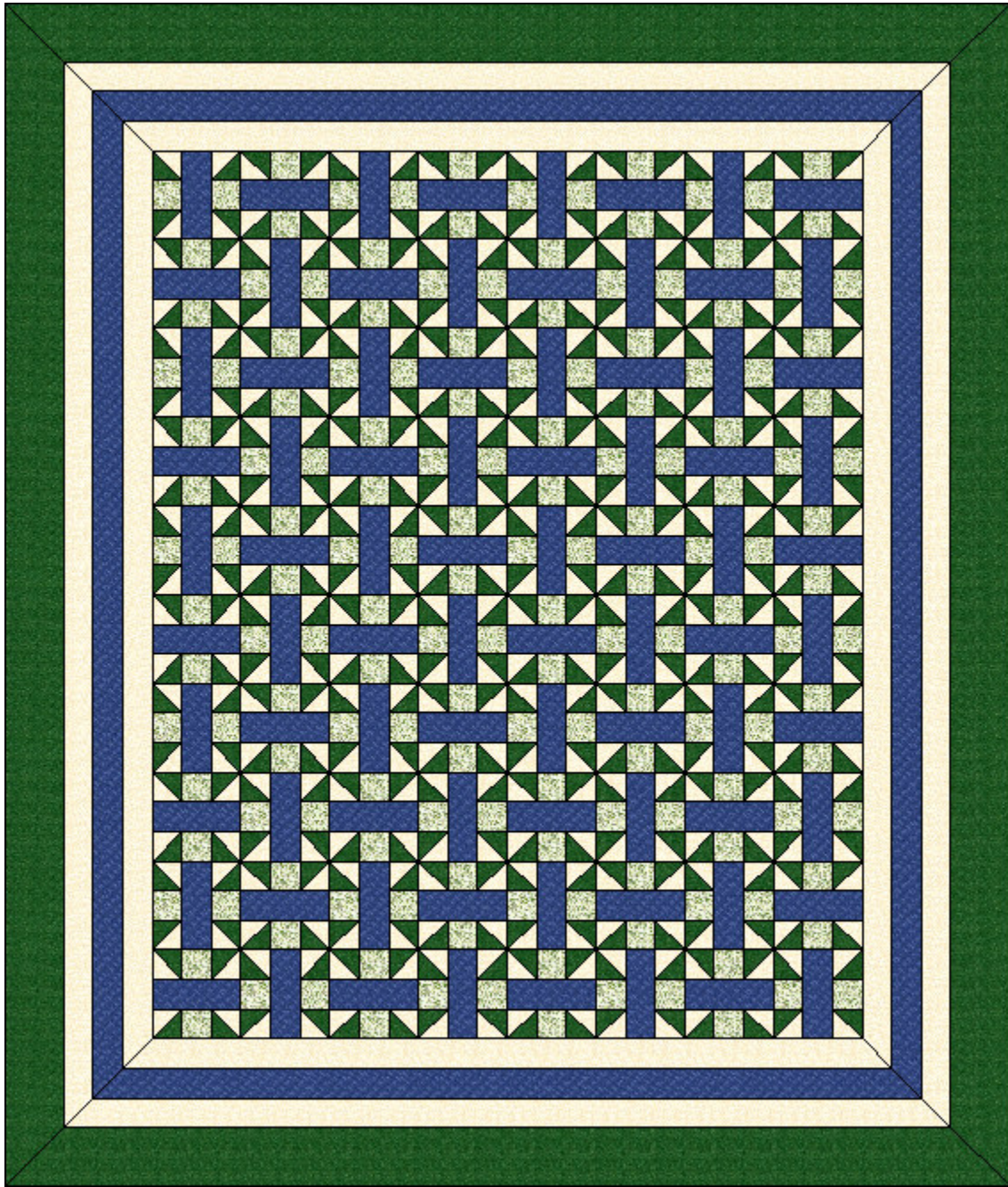


Light green print 3/4 yard



Binding color of choice 2/3 yard cut into 8 strips that measure 2 1/2" each strip. Sew together to make one long strip for at least 312" of binding.
