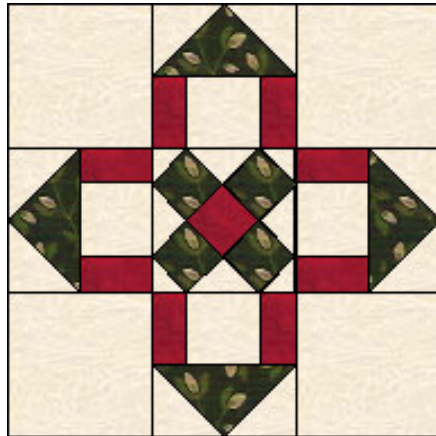

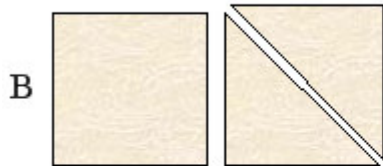


Queen Anne

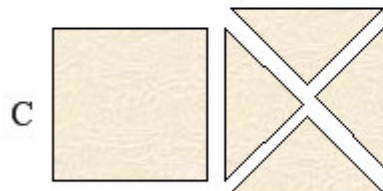
12" Finished Block



Cut 1 square 1 7/8"




Cut 2 squares 1 7/8" and then
subcut these into 4 triangles





Cut 1 square 3 1/4" and then
subcut this into 4 triangles





Cut 4 squares 1 7/8"

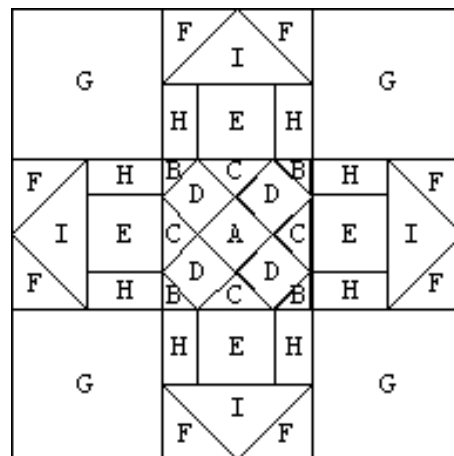
E  Cut four squares 2 1/2"

F  Cut four squares 2 7/8" and then subcut these into 8 triangles

G  Cut 4 squares that are 4 1/2"

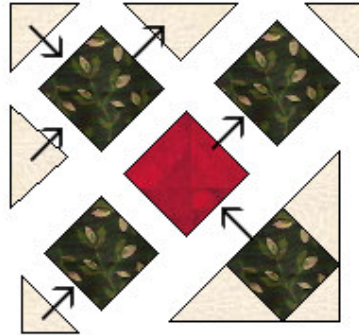
H  Cut 8 rectangles that are 1 1/2" High by 2 1/2" Wide

I  Cut 1 square that is 5 1/4" and then subcut this into 4 triangles



Make the center section first.

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew your center section pieces together as shown



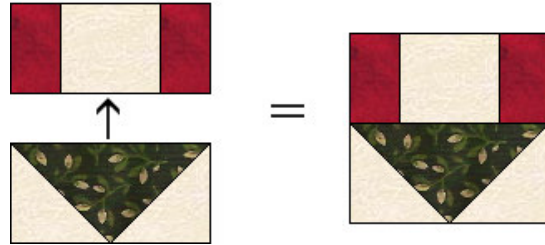
Next, using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew the red rectangles to the cream $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares making a total of 4 units



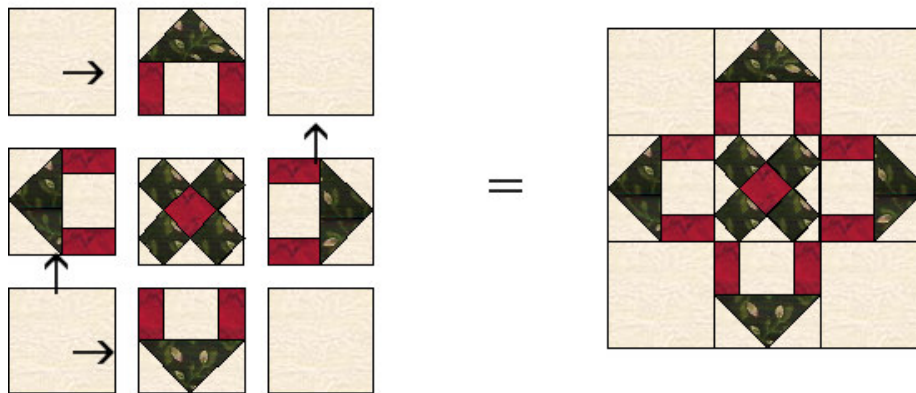
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew the geese blocks together making a total of 4 units



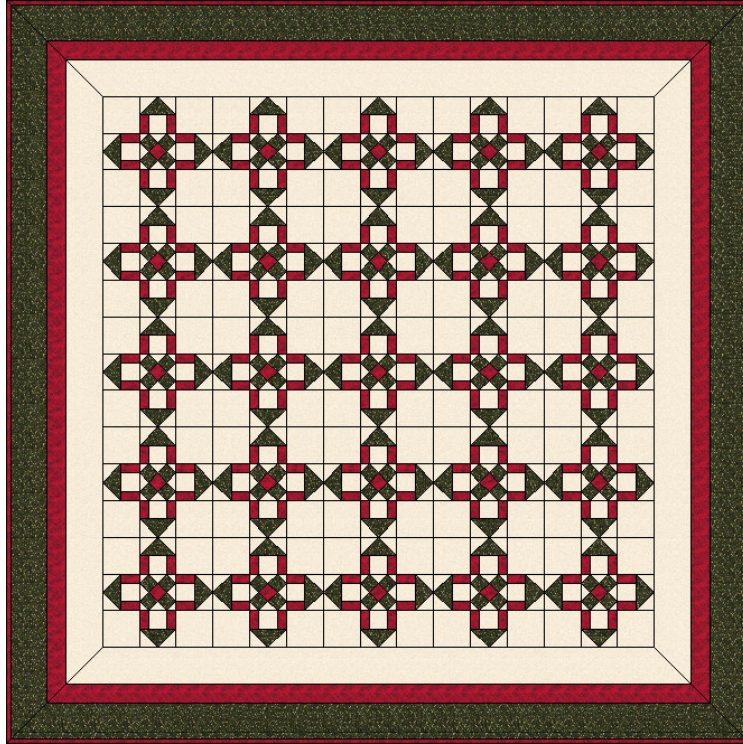
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew the geese blocks and your red and white blocks together make a total of 4 units.



Lay out all your units that you have sewn using the picture as your guide and using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance, sew your block together making sure to press gently.



Your block should now measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unfinished!

Total of 25 "Queen Anne" blocks in the example quilt

3 Borders:

4" cream, 2" red, and a 4" green border with color of choice for binding

Yardage to make this quilt:

2 ¼ yards of Green print

2 ¼ yards of Red Batik

3 ¾ yards of Cream Print

1 yard of color of choice for binding

Binding Of Choice

Cut 9 strips that are 3 ½" wide by width of fabric for a 1 ½" finished binding

Backing

7 yards if piecing together

2 ½ yards If using an extra wide muslin backing

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
