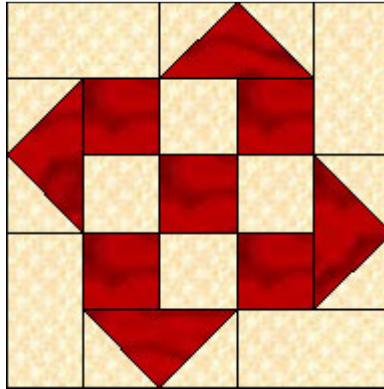
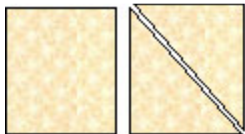


The Golden Thimble

Rolling Nine Patch
10" Finished Block



Cut 4 squares that are $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " and then subcut these into 8 triangles



Cut 4 rectangles that are $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " by $4 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut one square that is $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " and then subcut this into 4 triangles

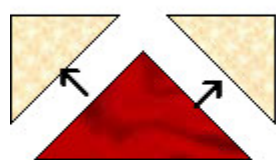
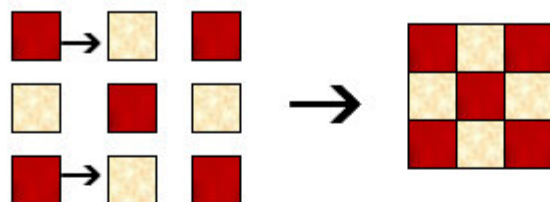


Cut 4 squares that are $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "



Cut 5 squares that are $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "

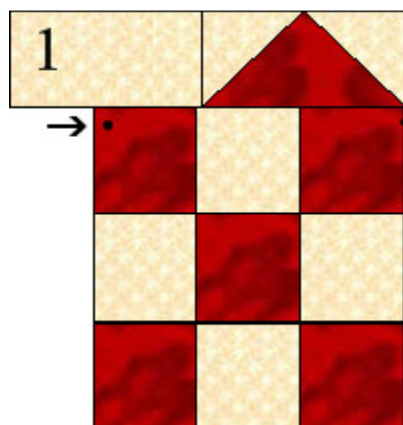
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew the squares together making a nine patch unit as shown



Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew the red triangles and the cream triangles together making 4 units as shown

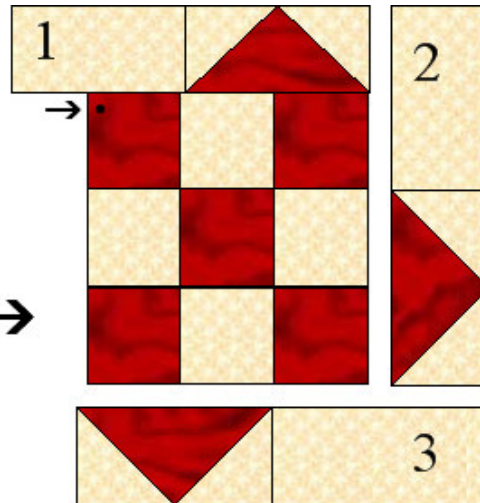


Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew the triangles units together with the cream rectangles making a total of 4 units as shown

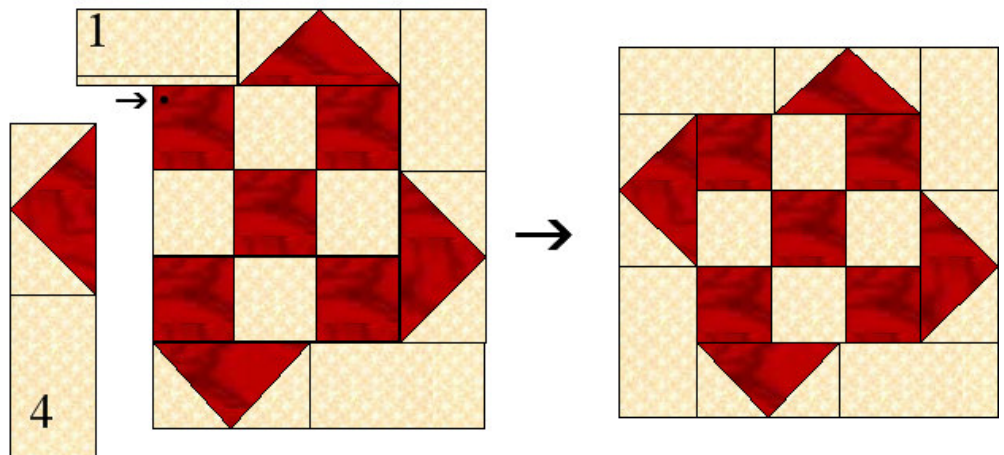


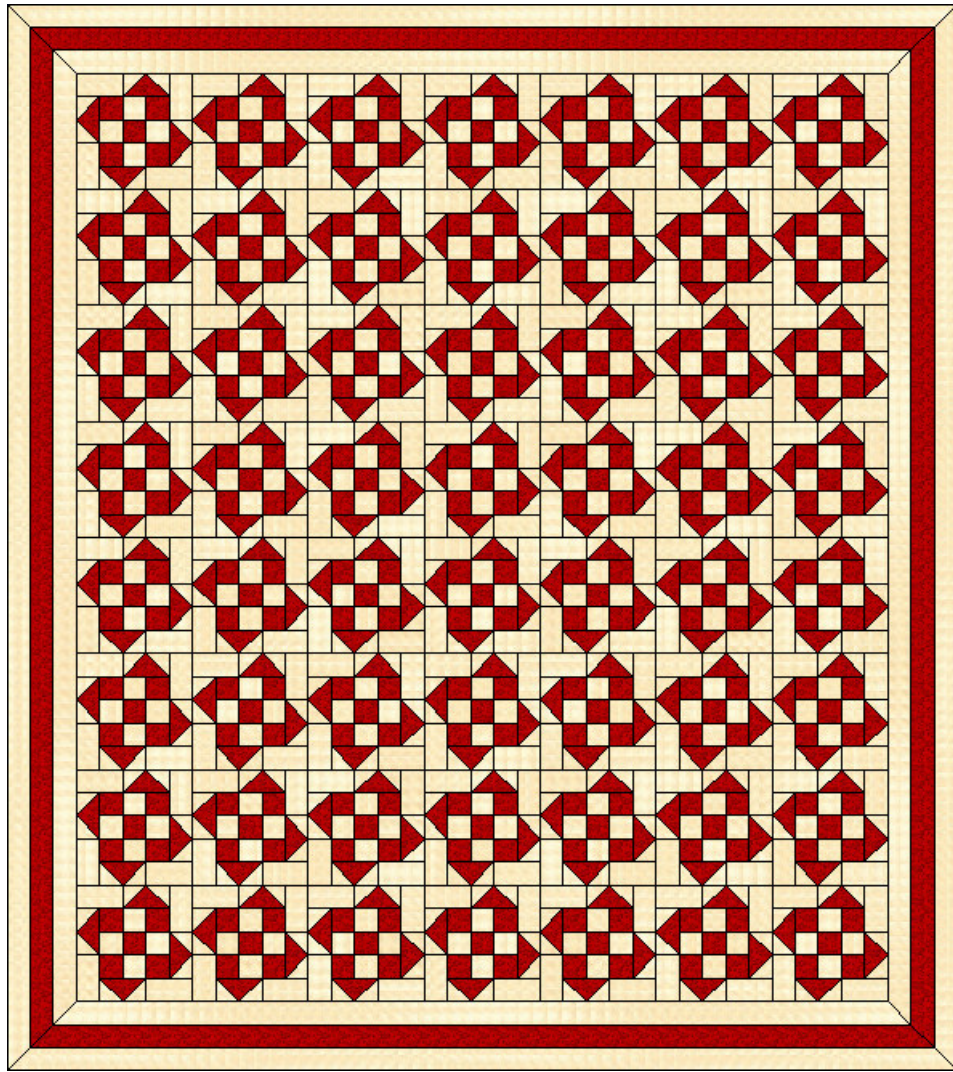
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance begin to sew on this side. Sew across until you get within $\frac{1}{4}$ " of the end and stop, leaving the $\frac{1}{4}$ " open.

Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew the rest of the pieces on the sides of your nine patch in the number sequence shown.



Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew the final piece on. Turn back the rectangle on the #1 section that you left open when you sewed on the 1st strip. Sew on #4 strip and then press gently. Continue to finish sewing the seam that was left open and press





82" by 92"

7 Blocks across by 8 blocks down for a total of 56 blocks in this quilt

3 Mitered borders at 2" each
